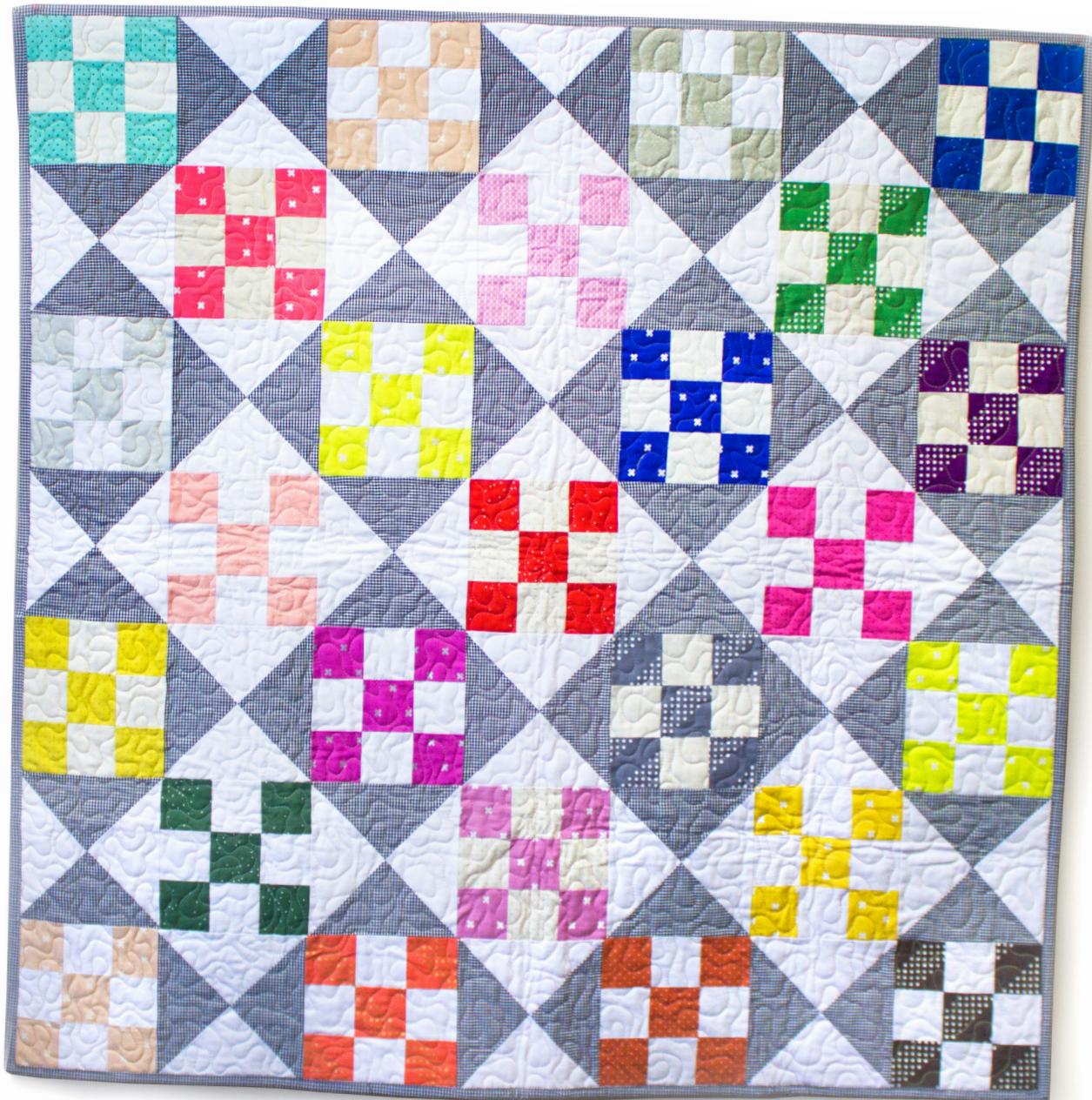


# Thoroughly Modern Nine Patch

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# Supply List

## Fabric:

- 1/2 yard of white or light colored fabric
- 18 different fabric Fat Eighths (or you can use scraps)
- 2/3 yard of white fabric
- 2/3 yard of a gray fabric (or black and white checked)

## Thread:

- Cotton + Steel 12 Pack Basics Collection  
**This collection contains:** 753-1005 – Black, 753-1245 – Dk. Gold Green, 753-1001 – Bright White, 753-1295 – Sterling, 753-1046 – Teal, 753-1037 – Light Red, 753-1115 – Light Pink, 753-1256 – Sweet Pink, 753-1197 – Medium Navy, 753-1192 – Fuchsia, 753-1901 – Neon Yellow, 753-1366 – Greig

## Dimensions:

The quilt measures 42” square finished. Each block is 6 1/2” and will finish at 6”.

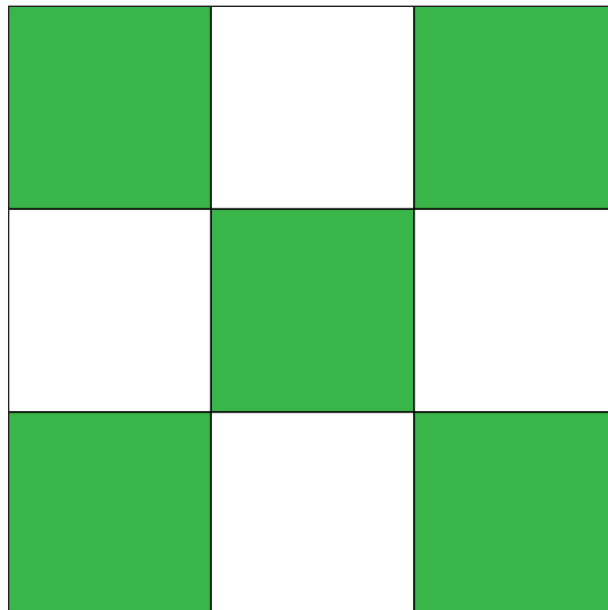
## Cutting Instructions:

- 100 - 2 1/2” squares from a white or light colored fabric
- 125 - 2 1/2” squares from multi colored fabrics
- 12 - 7 1/2” squares from a white fabric
- 12 - 7 1/2” squares from a gray fabric

## For the 9 Patch Blocks

For each block assemble three rows of three 2 1/2” squares. Use the diagram below for color placement.

You will need to make 25 blocks.

# Instructions

## Step 1 - Hourglass Blocks

Draw a diagonal line corner to corner on the back of one of the white 7 1/2" squares.

### Step 2

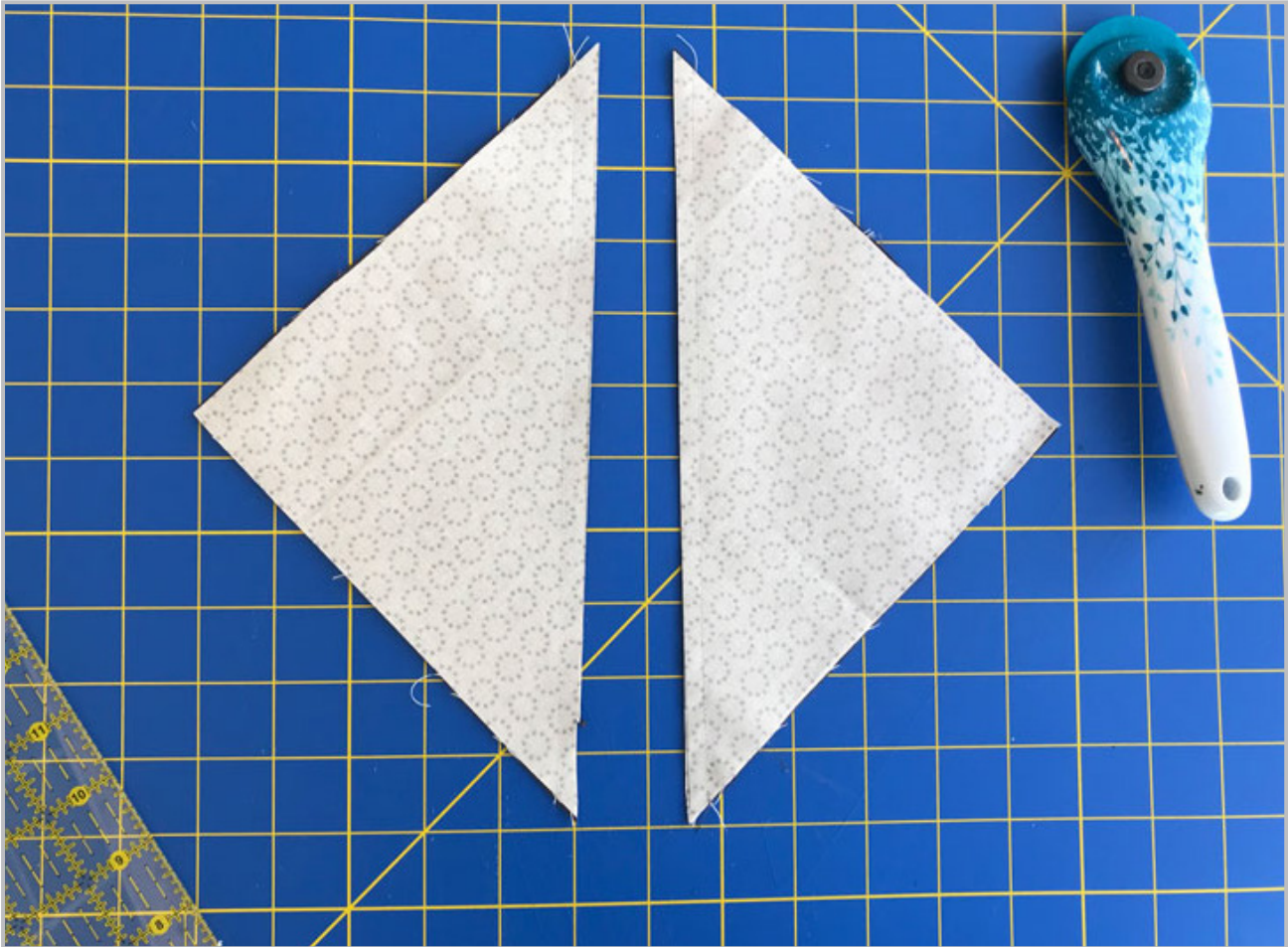
Place a 7 1/2" white square RS together with a 7.5" gray square. Sew 1/4" away on each side of the line you drew.

Step 3

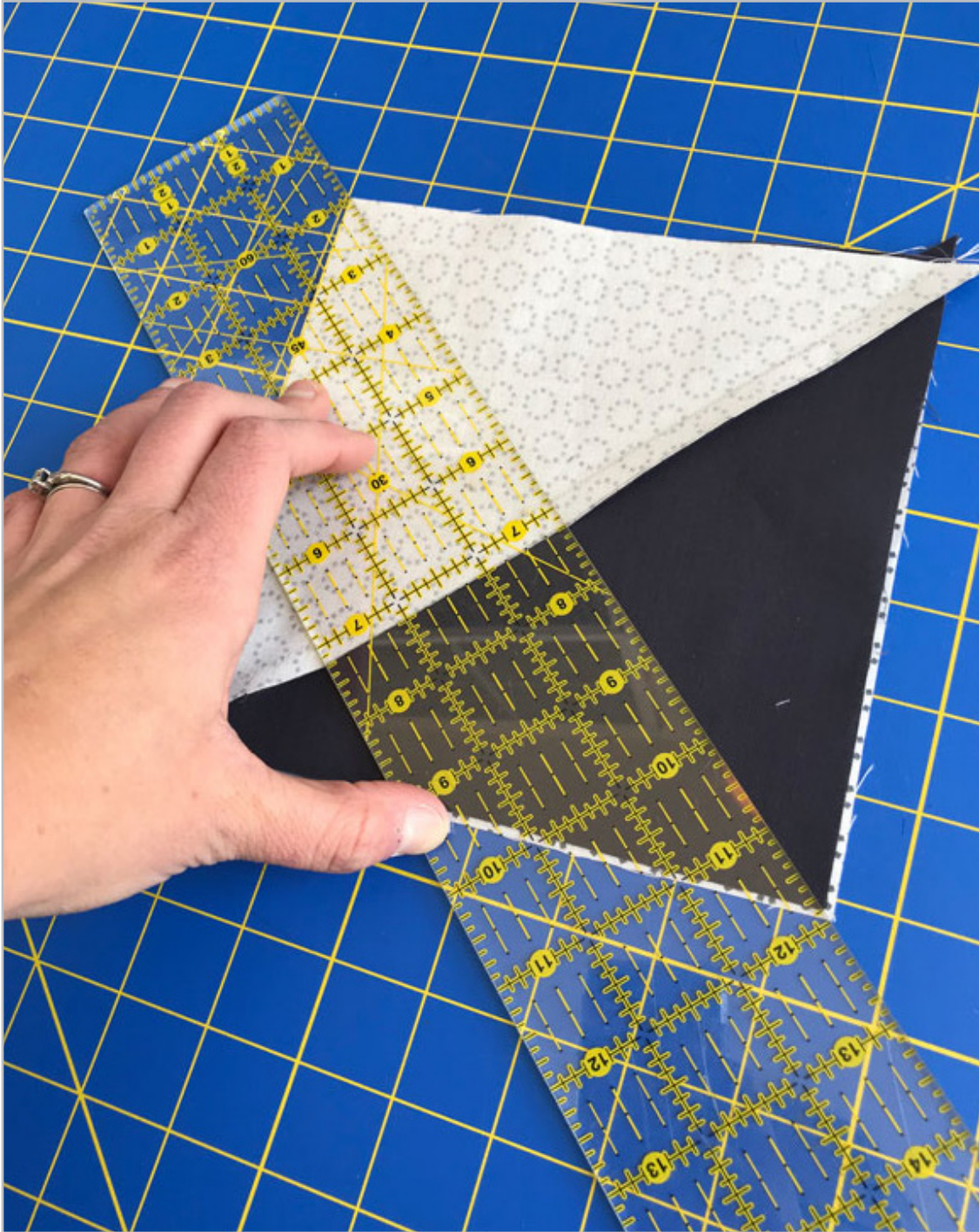
Cut along the line you drew, leaving two half-square triangle blocks.



## Instructions - continued

### Step 4

Press the seams to the gray side on each block. On the back of one of the blocks, draw a diagonal line that is perpendicular to the seam.

## Instructions - continued

### Step 5

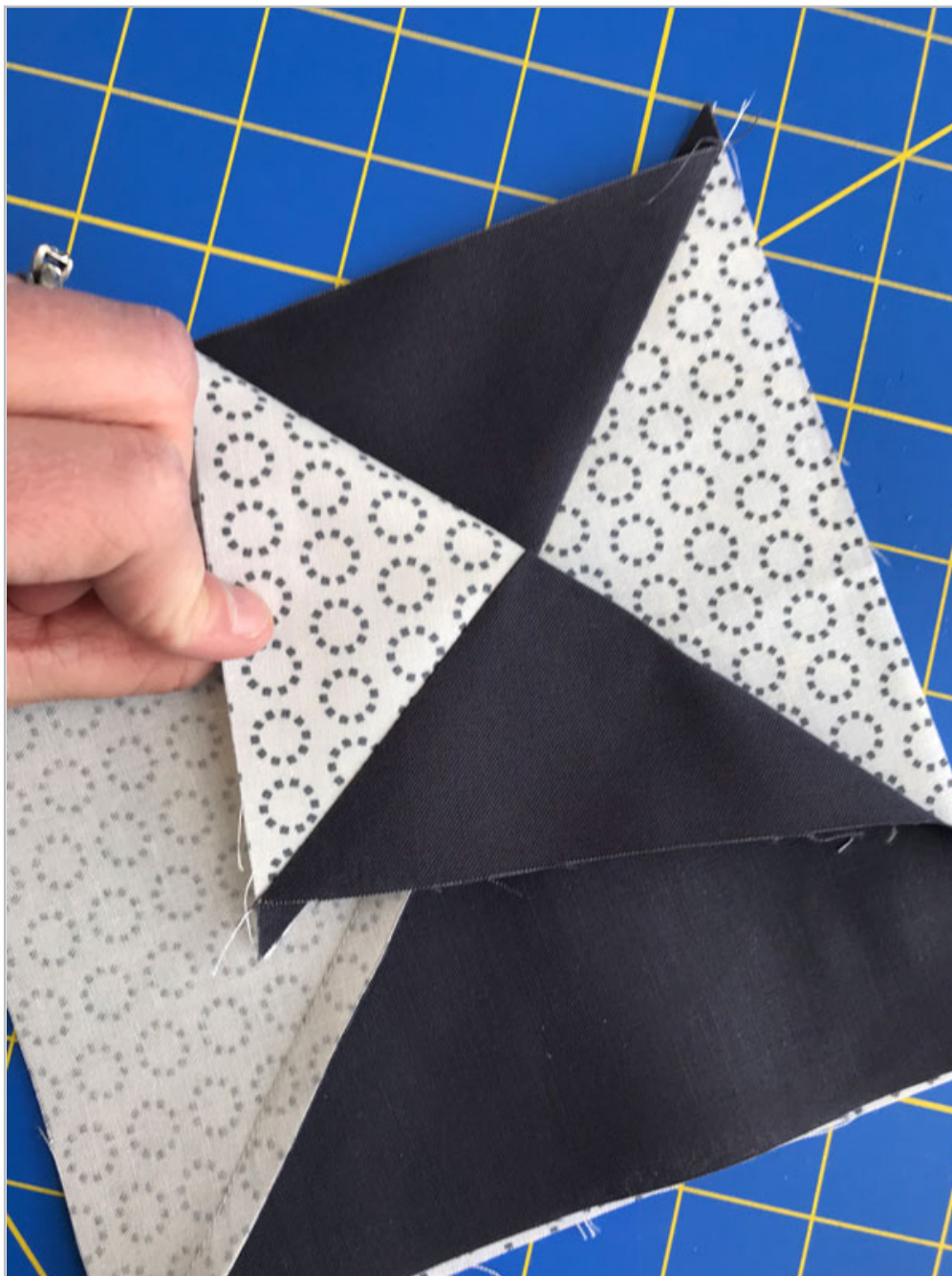
Place the two blocks RS together, nesting the seams. The white triangle will match up with the alternating block's gray triangle.



## Instructions - continued

### Step 6

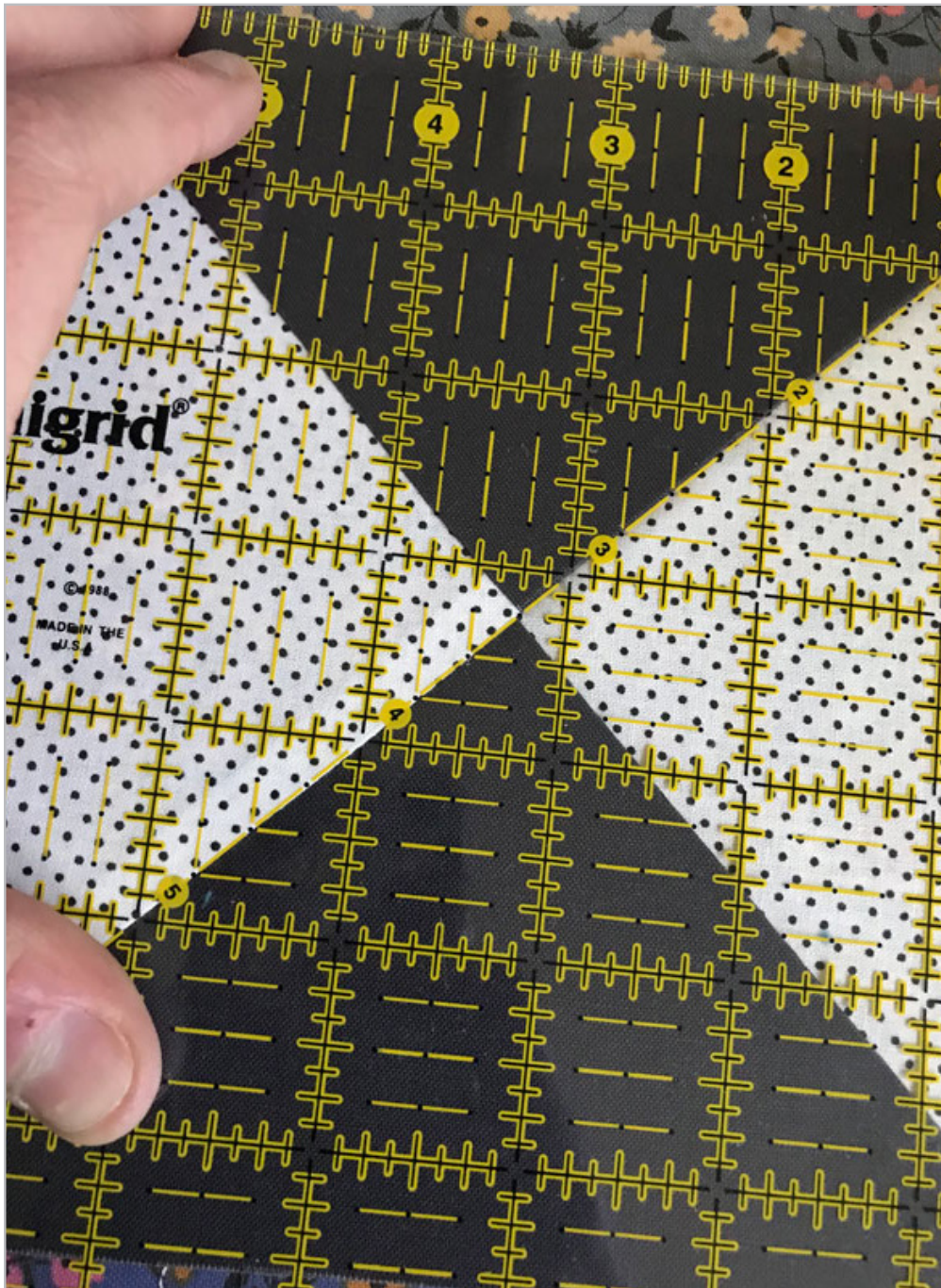
Again, sew 1/4" away on each side of the drawn line and then cut along the line. This will make two hourglass blocks.



## Instructions - continued

### Step 7

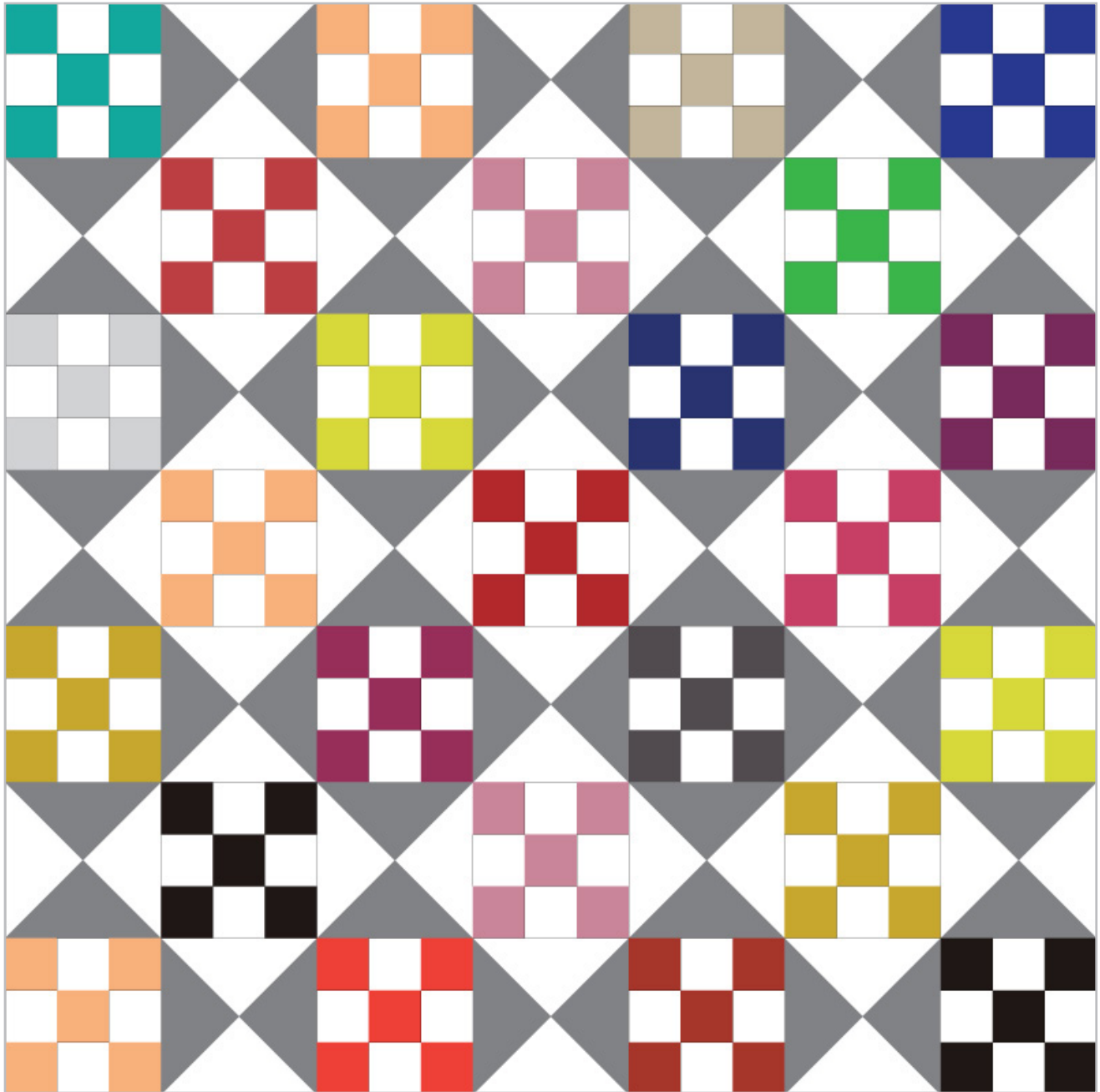
Trim the blocks to 6 1/2" making sure the ruler's 3 1/4" mark is at the center when trimming. Repeat for all twelve 7 1/2" squares.

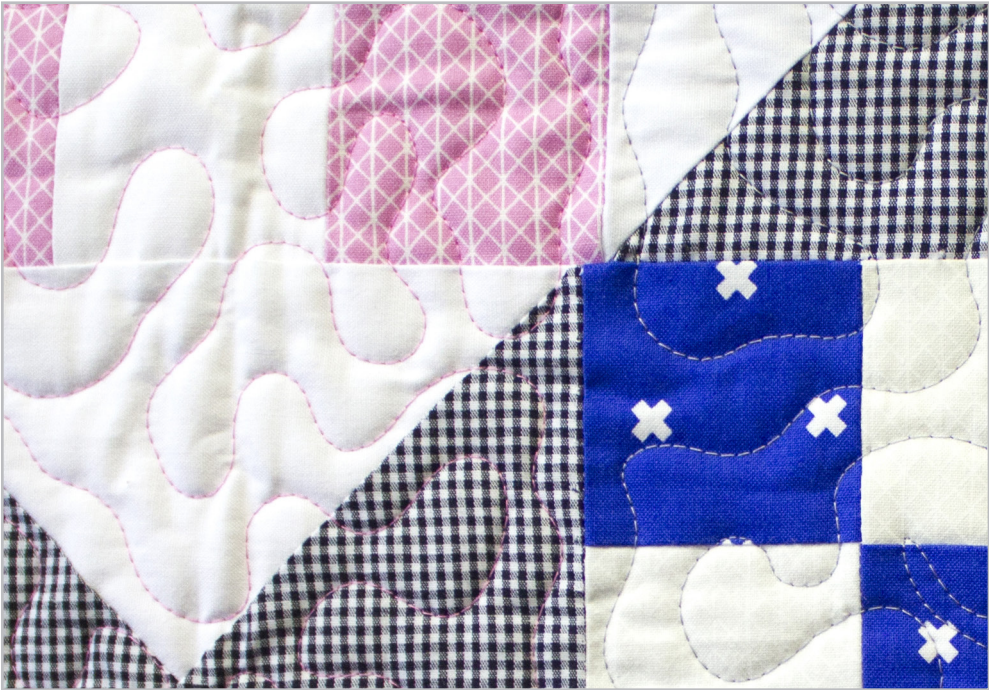
Once you have all your blocks, assemble based on the diagram. Take care to pay attention to the direction of the hourglass blocks.

## Quilting

Quilt as desired using a variety of colors from the Cotton + Steel 12 Pack Basics Collection. We did a meander changing the thread color every row.
